Rules and Guidelines

- 5,000 words or less
- Poetry, flash fiction, short stories, and personal essays welcome
- All genres
- Submissions must:
 - Be in .doc, .docx, or .rtf format
 - Use a 12-point standard font
 - Be double spaced with one-inch margins
 - Contain no personal identifying information, including author name, anywhere in the file (including the file name)
- Unpublished works only
- Please send us your best work—only one entry per author
- No simultaneous submissions (with the exception of the <u>League of Utah</u>
 <u>Writers Woolley Awards Contest</u>, to which we encourage you to
 submit this work)
- You must be a member in good standing of the League of Utah Writers to submit (if you are not sure if your membership is active, please email membership@leagueofutahwriters.org)
- We are not looking for stories which include graphic rape and/or sexual assault, or which promote ableism, racism, sexism, homophobia, or transphobia

Selected submissions will be paid .03 cents per word (or a flat rate of \$15 for accepted poetry) and will receive a print copy of the anthology.
